Dear Vice Chair Anderson

I have recently received John Woon's request to dismiss my case. He stated this is "due to not having met the deadline set for a medical assessment and note." At this time, I am requesting NOT to have this case dismissed for the following reasons.

On Wed. April 26, 2006, I will be seeing Dr. Macmichael to further discuss this issue. At this time, I will obtain a doctor's note for the 2 appointments in 2005/6. The appointments involved assessing my mental state and fitness to teach. I do not expect Dr. Macmichael to comment on the matter of what I am challenging the school system with. This may jeopardize his medical profession.

I have not been under the care of a psychiatrist. Questions that Bernard Hanson proposed to "my attending psychiatrist" cannot be objectively answered in reflection to a doctor's opinion of my mental state and fitness to work as a teacher.

Ed Chudak made an appointment with Dr. Hy Bloom on Feb. 10 2005 and the closest date he could get an appointment was April 9, 2005. The delay is inevitable for any medical appointment today. On a professional level, Dr. Hy Bloom could not make a professional assessment based a letter sent to him without meeting and treating me for a period of time.
